KYSA has a total membership of over 5,600 youth with more than 780 teams participating in the KYSA Leagues. In addition to Sports, the KYSA Zonal Leaders, Volunteers and committee Members are involved in a range of community services such as Slum - garbage collection, trees planting, Aids Prevention, leadership training, and organizing Prayers to schools and community teams.

The main objectives are:

- a. To encourage and empower KYSA teams on integrating sports and life skills;
- b. To create positive attitudes and improve more girl's participation in sports.
- c. Advocate for behaviour change, by creating greater awareness on HIV/AIDS and substance abuse through KYSA peer educators and mentors.
- d. To give girls a chance to test and improve their football skills and teamwork.
- e. Mobilize many girls to form more teams in order to improve girls' participation in the KYSA and Schools leagues at large.

Committee

The Kysa championships was organized by the KYSA Sports with the support and cooperation of the entire Karura Centre staff and sports teachers. The championships was officiated by 16 KYSA trained male referees and 8 KYSA trained female referees.



If anyone has any lawful reason why these two should not be joined in Holy Matrimony, kindly contact the church office through 0721990880. (3rd announcement)


