1. Leaning on God's word

The central role of God's Word in the life of the early church and its mission is shown in the predominance of sermons - God's word throughout Acts. About a third of the book of Acts consists of these speeches or sermons, most of them by Peter or Paul proclaiming the gospel.

- Acts 2:42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching
- Acts 6:7 And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem...
- In Acts 7, Stephen responds to his accusers by going back to God's word
- Acts 12:24 But the word of God increased and multiplied.
- Acts 13:49 And the word of the Lord was spreading throughout the whole region.

 Acts 19:20 So the word of the Lord continued to increase and prevail mightily
